- In colonial time, apples were called winter banana or melt-in-the-mouth.
- It takes about 36 apples to create one gallon of apple cider.
- Don't peel your apple. Two-thirds of the fiber and lots of antioxidants are found in the peel. Antioxidants help to reduce damage to cells, which can trigger some diseases.
