Town Council Meeting
September 8, 2015

Called To Order @ 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

Councilperson Redding, Mayor Sand, Councilperson Stinnette, Councilperson Schirmer present and accounted for. Councilperson Clark absent.

Approval of Agenda:

Motion made by Councilperson Redding and seconded by Councilperson Schirmer to approve agenda. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:

Motion made by Councilperson Redding and seconded by Councilperson Stinnette to approve the minutes from the August 3, 2015 Town Council meeting, the special meeting on August 12, 2015 for 3rd Street construction and the special meeting on August 31, 2015 for the first reading of Fire Ordinance #295. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Bills:

Bills and payroll approved. Motion made by Councilperson Stinnette and seconded by Councilperson Redding to approve the bills. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously. Bills submitted for public view.

Reports:

1. Director of water and sewer report, Steve Kelley
Steve Kelley will give copy of water reports to the Town Hall for review.
Steve fixed a toy at the park.
He will check a water leak on 3rd Street.

2. Treasurer report, Patti Pierson.
Reports acknowledged and seconded to approve as presented for public review. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously. Treasurer's report given to public review.

Old Business:

1. Ordinance #293 – Sewer
Motion made by Councilperson Stinnette and seconded by Councilperson Redding to accept the 2nd reading of Ordinance #293 with changes to Section 18 regarding fees for any violations of this section. All in favor.
Motion passed unanimously.
2. Ordinance #294 – Water
Motion made by Councilperson Stinnette and seconded by Councilperson Redding to accept the 2nd reading of Ordinance #294. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Community Center Parking Lot

Steve will be putting roto-mill on the parking lot of the Community Center. This should be completed within 4 weeks. This needs to be done as quickly as possible due to weather.

New Business:

1. Platte County Emergency Operation Plan (EOP) presented by Terry Stevenson.

Motion made by Councilperson Schirmer and seconded by Councilperson Redding to sign off on the Platte County Emergency Operation Plan. Fire Chief Tim Ash has approved the plan. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

2. School Cross-walk Painting

Steve Kelley will order the paint and complete this assignment as soon as the paint comes in. Painting handicapped parking signs will also be completed next to the cross walk, in 2 places at the high school and at the Community Center.

Wyoming Business Council will meet September 10, 2015 in Sheridan, Wyoming to decide if Horton's Corner Grant gets approved. Mayor Sand will be leaving for Sheridan on September 9, 2015 to attend the meeting.

- John Burns raised the issue of the Chugwater sign on Dan Rogers property missing some panels. Since it may be on the verge of being sold, nothing will be done about the sign at this time.

- The Stop Sign on the pathway near Buffalo Drive has gone missing again. Steve will put up a new one.
- A Stop Sign needs to be put up on 6th and Buffalo Drive.
- People have been driving on the sidewalk on 7th and this issue needs to be addressed.
- Kathy Metcalf discussed the weeds and goatheads on the sidewalks and streets on the west end of town being a problem.
- Russ and Tina Kirilin discussed a water rate study that we had asked Rural Water to help us with and it had never gotten done due to no follow-up contact from Rural Water.
