MEETING CALLED TO ORDER at 19:00

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL:

Mayor Redding, Councilperson Cronk, Councilperson Burns, Councilperson Marlatt were present. Councilperson Schirmer was absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Councilperson Cronk made a motion that the Agenda be approved. Councilperson Marlatt seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:

Motion made by Councilperson Marlatt to accept February 03, 2020 Town Council meeting minutes. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Travelers Insurance is raising the premium and the deductible for Wind/Hail.

3. Ched Update given by Philip Ellis. 70 people attended the annual meeting. 26 people have paid annual dues with 16 of those being from the town. Plans are in progress for a Music Festival to be held August 14 & 15, 2020.

OLD BUSINESS:

City Attorney gave an update on the progress of the easement for the Woody Martin property located on 3rd Street.

Mayor Redding read a letter from Barb Fletcher saying she was resigning her position as leader of the first responders in Chugwater.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ruth Vaughn from the Cemetery District requested that the Town continue to dig graves at the cemetery. Councilperson Burns made a motion that the Town continues to dig the graves at the cemetery provided the Town has the equipment to do so. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Danna Cushman/Jeremy Westerman gave first year report on the gym. The gym has 34 active members. The average use ranges from 3-5 per day. There is a Zumba and Yoga class being held

taught by La Verna Anderson and Danna Cushman. North Platte Physical Therapy is interested in using gym along with renting one of the offices spaces. The Town will revisit North Platte PT in the future.

Motion was made by Councilperson Burns to pay Platte County Parks and Rec \$1,824.00 per the contract which states that 50% of the gym memberships collected will be returned to Parks & Rec. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Chili Cook-off- Kim McBryant requested use of the park, community center, and concession stand for the 2020 Chugwater Chili Cook-off.

Town of Chugwater sponsorship- Councilperson Marlatt made a motion that the Town sponsors the 2020 Chugwater Chili Cook-off in the amount of \$1,000.00. Councilperson Burns seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Woody Martin- Property on 2nd Street, issue with broken pipes. City Attorney Jones gave Woody a form to fill out for LGLP.

Lance explained that there should be enough money left over from 2nd and 4th Street projects to install a reverse curb/gutter on 2nd Street next to the parking space at the park. This would prevent the breakdown of the pavement that was just installed. Councilperson Marlatt made a motion that curb/gutter be placed on 2nd Street by the Park parking lot provided that there is not a cost overrun on the 4th Street project. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion passed.
