STATE OF WYOMING SHORTFALL

- The Governor's budget plan calls for \$19 million in standard budget reductions for the upcoming 2-year period.
- The Joint Appropriations Committee said that deeper cuts might be needed to brace for a prolonged economic downturn.
- Wyoming's energy revenues lag far behind expectations.
- The State's projected revenues through June 2018 will be about \$617 million less than what was anticipated at the start of the year.
