MEETING CALLED TO ORDER at 19:00

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL:

Mayor Redding, Councilperson Cronk, Councilperson Burns, Councilperson Marlatt were present. Councilperson Schirmer was absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Councilperson Marlatt made a motion that the Agenda be approved. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:

Motion made by Councilperson Cronk to accept October 7, 2019 Town Council meeting minutes. Seconded by Councilperson Burns. Motion passed.

Reports were made public during November 04, 2019 Town Hall meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

City Attorney Jones reported on progress made with easements for Woody Martin property. Attorney Jones not present.

City Attorney Jones reported on the status of the roofing bid advertisement. Working with City Engineer Romig. Attorney Jones not present.

Lynn Brann-asked if something could be done about the billboard North of Chugwater. Lance and Kelly are to find out which billboard she is referring to. Action tabled. Councilperson Marlatt reported that there are two billboards one North and South that the Town own. They are in need of repainting. Lance will address this spring before Chugwater Chili Cookoff 2020.

NEW BUSINESS:

Approval/Renewal of Liquor Licensees: Council person Marlatt made a motion that the liquor licenses for the Buffalo Lodge/Grill, Stampede Eatery, and the Chugwater Soda Fountain be renewed. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Discussion was held about the Sanitation Enterprise fund losing money during fiscal year 2018/2019 and likely hood that it will lose money in fiscal year 2019/2020. Subject will have to be discussed during the next budget cycle with the possibility of raising rates.

Jennifer Clark- Dog complaint, not only from Jennifer but concern was expressed about the dog being at the school when kids are at recess. Complaint emailed to City Attorney Jones to respond by letter to the Town Resident.

Letter from Services for Seniors: Services for Seniors requested that the Town waive November 2019 rent. Services for Seniors paid \$1,200.00 to have the Hobart dishwasher repaired. Council agreed to the request. To make up the \$600.00 for rent the Town will take \$600.00 from the \$2,000.00 that was given to the Community Center as part of the Chugwater Chili Cookoff payout. Also, Mayor Redding is having City Attorney review and revises the contract between the Town and Service for Seniors which expired June 2019

Barb/Gerry Dayton were granted a variance to construct a windbreak at their house located 219 7th Street. Councilperson Burns made the motion and Councilperson Cronk seconded. Motion passed.
