Lead and Copper Survey

Pete Delgado interduces Colby Romig with JEO Consulting. Colby started with a bit of history as follows, JEO Consulting has been the been the town of Chugwater's engineer firm sense 2006.

The Lead and Copper rule was introduced in 1991 because of concerns with the heavy contaminates in the publics drinking water.

In 1986 there was a law put into place to stop the installation of lead pipes.

LCR revised the rule in 2004, 2006, 2016, with final ruling in 2021.

Lead and Copper Survey has to be sent in to EPA October 16, 2024.

Information Coby Stated went as follows:

The last test Chugwater did the Lead reading was at .008 and the Copper reading was at .27. The amounts cannot exceed Copper 1.3 and Lead .015 per EPA standards.

If the surveys are turned in as unknown, they will be considered as Lead. He also stated that if there are Lead pipes in homes, it is a gray area. EPA may give the person 10 years to replace.

Galvanized pipes are fine. They are not a concern.

Colby also stated he does not think Chugwater has Lead lines.
